

# FINANCE FROM THE FRONT



We surveyed doctors, nurses and allied health professionals on the front line on what their views were of prices and costs in the NHS. They highlighted three key messages.

## DECISIONS OF VALUE

### 1. MOST CLINICIANS DON'T KNOW ABOUT NHS PRICES AND COSTS



However, length of service is **linked to knowledge of prices and costs**

Least experienced clinicians  
(0 to 5 years)

**7%** know prices **7%** know costs

Less experienced clinicians  
(5 to 15 years)

**34%** know prices **35%** know costs


More experienced clinicians  
(15 to 25 years)

**36%** know prices **34%** know costs

Most experienced clinicians  
(25+ years)


**44%** know prices **51%** know costs

### 2. MOST CLINICIANS THINK NHS PRICES DON'T COVER COSTS




However, clinicians who know about NHS prices and costs are **more likely** to think prices cover costs than clinicians who don't know
