Supporting healthcare as the UK leaves the EU

We aim to make sure that patients, and the healthcare sector that supports them, are in the strongest possible position once the UK leaves the EU. We ask for this to be achieved through:

Research

Maximum levels of research and innovation collaboration with the EU, so UK patients and the public can benefit from EU networks and clinical studies.

Regulation

Alignment with the EU on the regulation of medicines and medical devices to ensure patient safety and access to treatments.

Reciprocal healthcare

Straightforward and appropriate access to reciprocal healthcare for UK and EU patients, preferably by preserving current arrangements.

Public health and disease prevention

Protecting UK and EU citizens from risk to health through strong UK-EU coordination on pandemics, other threats and health promotion.

Funding

A strong commitment to funding the health and public health sectors, ensuring that any shortfall is offset.



The Brexit Health Alliance was established to make sure that the interests of those who use health services, as well as healthcare commissioners and providers, educators, researchers, and the healthcare industry are reflected in the negotiations as the formal process of leaving the EU gets underway.
