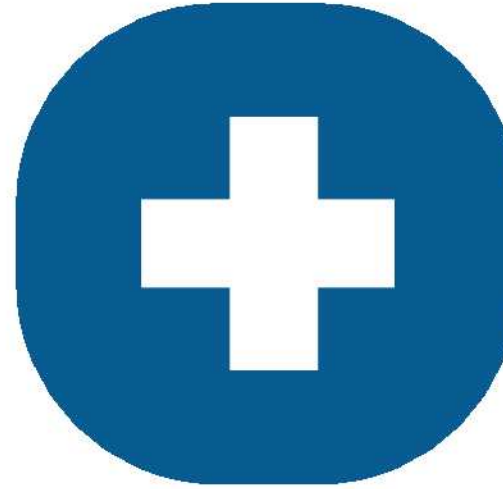

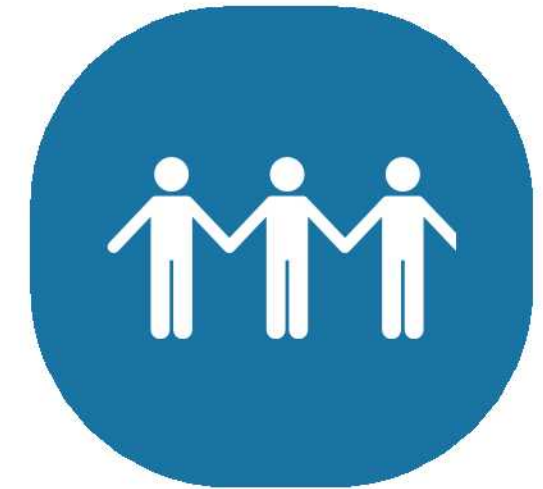

Austin's Thriving Region

- Austin is the fastest growing MSA by GDP with 30% increase in population since 2010.
- Hospitals alone added 1800 new jobs in 2024
- \$2.5B investment to launch the UT Austin Medical Center
- MD Anderson coming in 2029-30
- Home of 9/10 of the highest-revenue US tech companies
- Currently home to over 300 health tech and life science companies and growing
- 2x the concentration of software engineers than average US city

Regional 5-Year Innovation Funding in MedTech

Over \$440M in VC funding in Medtech Devices and Supplies in past 5 years with heavy concentration of therapeutics and diagnostics.

Over \$5B in VC funding in Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning

Over \$740M of VC funding for Healthcare Technology Systems

Total combined investment in bio and health is estimated at \$3.5B putting Austin in top 10 cities for bio and health funding.¹
